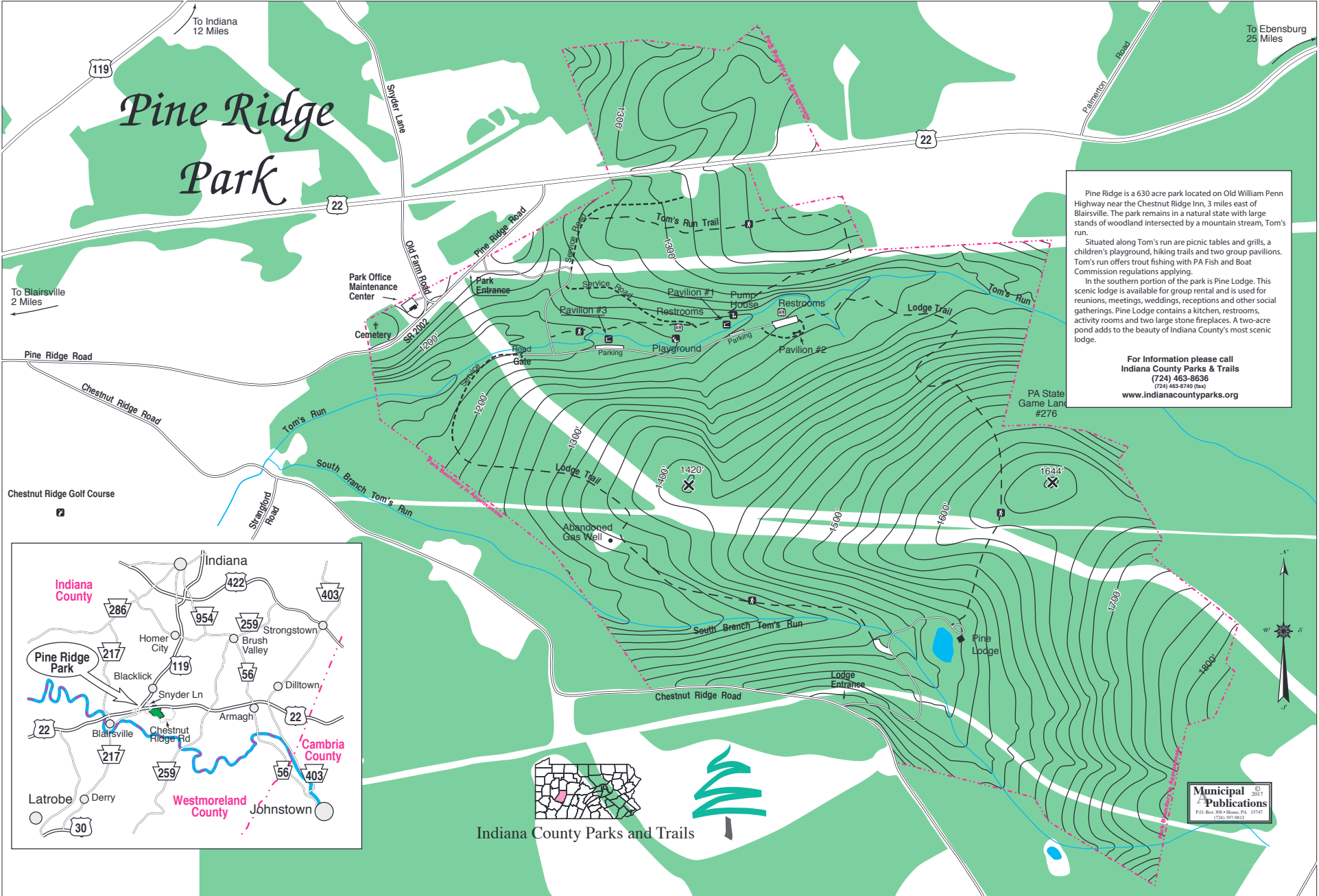


# Pine Ridge Park

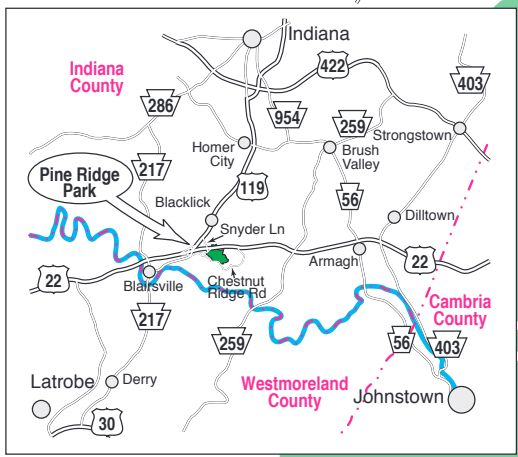


Pine Ridge is a 630 acre park located on Old William Penn Highway near the Chestnut Ridge Inn, 3 miles east of Blairsville. The park remains in a natural state with large stands of woodland intersected by a mountain stream, Tom's run.

Situated along Tom's run are picnic tables and grills, a children's playground, hiking trails and two group pavilions. Tom's run offers trout fishing with PA Fish and Boat Commission regulations applying.

In the southern portion of the park is Pine Lodge. This scenic lodge is available for group rental and is used for reunions, meetings, weddings, receptions and other social gatherings. Pine Lodge contains a kitchen, restrooms, activity rooms and two large stone fireplaces. A two-acre pond adds to the beauty of Indiana County's most scenic lodge.
